# **Privacy policy**

## Information on the processing of personal data of users of the https://hackedlist.io/ website

in accordance with the provisions of Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (hereinafter referred to as the "GDPR"), and taking into account the general principles of the GDPR.

## 1. Personal data controller

In relation to the management and processing of personal data as defined in the GDPR and further specified below in this Information, **CyWeTa DNS s.r.o.** is the main controller and also the processor of personal data, with its registered office at K Noskovně 579, Nebušice, 164 00 Praha 6, registered in the Commercial Register maintained by the Municipal Court in Prague, Section C, Insert 377716, ID No.: 17843863 (hereinafter referred to as the "**Controller**" or "**CyWeTa DNS**"), which takes the main decisions regarding the purposes and means of processing personal data and is thus the main establishment (see point 36 of the preamble to the GDPR Regulation). The Controller operates and is responsible for the processing of personal data collected through the websites <a href="https://hackedlist.io/">https://hackedlist.io/</a> and

# 2. Method of obtaining personal data

The personal data of the users of the <a href="https://hackedlist.io/">https://hackedlist.io/</a> website (hereinafter referred to as "User" or "Users") is obtained by CyWeTa DNS directly from specific individuals at the moment when they:

- They visit the Website https://hackedlist.io/;
- They accept "cookies";
- Sign up for services provided by CyWeTa DNS; or
- Voluntarily provide your personal data through the form designed for communication between Users and CyWeTa DNS. \*

## 3. Purpose of processing of personal data

Personal data is processed by CyWeTa DNS in the form in which it was provided by the User, and only for the purposes set out below:

<sup>\*</sup> In the event that the User provides CyWeTa DNS with his/her personal data through the form for communication with CyWeTa DNS, he/she confirms that he/she is aware of the Information provided in this document before the first provision of personal data within the form.

- Sending commercial communications (direct marketing) (in accordance with point 47, point 70 and Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR) and furthermore in connection with the provisions of Section 7(3) of Act No. 480/2004 Coll., on certain information society services. In this case, the controller has a legitimate interest in the processing of personal data to promote the services and product offerings of the CyWeTa DNS Group;
- Management and Processing of personal data for the purpose of communication with specific Users in relation to the content of communication made via the contact form, to the contact email addresses of CyWeTa DNS or in the context of registration for subscription to services;
- For statistical purposes in anonymous form in order to optimize and improve the functioning of the website;
- In order to protect the servers from misuse by third parties as a legitimate interest of CyWeTa DNS within the meaning of Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR.

The controller declares that it does not process personal data in a way that is incompatible with the above purposes.

# 4. Scope of processing of personal data

Personal data collected from Users of the <a href="https://hackedlist.io/">https://hackedlist.io/</a> website and processed by CyWeTa DNS only to the extent necessary to achieve the purposes set out in Article 3 above.

In case the User visits the website <a href="https://hackedlist.io/">https://hackedlist.io/</a> and CyWeTa DNS automatically provides the following information:

- IP address;
- Information about the individual CyWeTa DNS sites he visited;
- the date and time the site was visited;
- referrer URL;

Data about access to and use of the https://hackedlist.io/ website are stored in log files.

In case the User uses the CyWeTa DNS contact form to communicate with CyWeTa DNS, CyWeTa DNS provides some of the following information:

- name and surname;
- e-mail;

If the User of the <a href="https://hackedlist.io/">https://hackedlist.io/</a> website provides CyWeTa DNS with additional Personal Data through the contact form on the website or in any other manner made available here, the General Data Protection Directive of the CyWeTa DNS Group applies to its management and processing.

Personal data collected through the <a href="https://hackedlist.io/">https://hackedlist.io/</a> website, including data provided via the contact form, is processed by CyWeTa DNS in an automated manner. Automated processing is the processing of personal data in which only automated information systems such as IT applications, software, etc. are used. When processing personal data, CyWeTa DNS does not use automated processing of personal data on the basis of which aspects of a person's behaviour are evaluated or predicted ("profiling").

## 5. Time of processing Personal Data

Personal data processed in connection with the operation of the <a href="https://hackedlist.io/">https://hackedlist.io/</a> website is processed by CyWeTa DNS for the time necessary to achieve the declared purposes of processing.

The personal data collected in connection with the use of the <a href="https://hackedlist.io/">https://hackedlist.io/</a> website is processed by CyWeTa DNS for the duration of the use of this website by a particular User and subsequently for a period of 4 years. The Controller has a legitimate interest in keeping this personal data in order to protect its rights in the event of potential litigation. After this period, the personal data will be disposed of in a secure manner.

The personal data of Users, provided via the contact form on the website <a href="https://hackedlist.io/">https://hackedlist.io/</a> or sent by email to the contact email addresses of CyWeTa DNS, will be processed for the period of time during which the mutual communication between the User and CyWeTa DNS takes place and subsequently for as long as it is strictly necessary to protect the rights and legitimate interests of both parties to the communication, taking into account the content of the mutual communication.

# 6. Transfer of Personal Data to third parties

The processing of personal data does not involve any unauthorised transfer of such data to a third country or international organisation.

The personal data of the Users of the <a href="https://hackedlist.io/">https://hackedlist.io/</a> website are not transferred for external processing. Personal data is processed directly by the Administrator (CyWeTa DNS).

# 7. Users' rights in relation to the processing of Personal Data

As a User of the <a href="https://hackedlist.io/">https://hackedlist.io/</a> website, you are able to exercise the following rights against CyWeTa DNS:

- Right of access to personal data (the right to obtain confirmation from the controller as to whether or not personal data relating to him/her is/is not processed in accordance with Article 15 of the GDPR);
- The right to revoke previously granted consent to the management and processing of personal data;
- Right to rectification of personal data;
- Right to erasure of personal data;
- Right to restriction of processing of personal data;
- the right to data portability;
- Right to a copy of personal data;
- the right to object to the processing of personal data,
- the right to lodge a complaint with the Office for Personal Data Protection and the right to effective judicial protection if the User considers that his rights under the GDPR have been violated as a result of the processing of personal data in violation of this Regulation.

The aforementioned rights can be exercised in written form addressed to the registered office of any company of the CyWeTa DNS group, via e-mail: support@hackelist.io, or in the case of a complaint to the supervisory authority, file a complaint with the supervisory authority, which is the Office for Personal Data Protection, located at Pplk. Sochora 727/27, Postal Code 170 00, Prague 7. We will provide you with our response or information about the measures taken as soon as possible after receiving your request.

If any commercial communication is disseminated by CyWeTa DNS to Users via electronic mail, it is clearly marked as a "commercial communication" and at the same time an indication is given as to

where and how the addressee may contact the sender with a request if he/she does not wish to continue receiving commercial information from the sender.

In accordance with point 70 and Article 21 of the GDPR, the Controller expressly draws the User's attention to the fact that, with regard to personal data processed **for the purpose of sending commercial communications** (direct marketing), the User has the right to object at any time, free of charge, to such processing of personal data (including profiling, insofar as it relates to such direct marketing), to the extent that the processing is related to the direct marketing in question, whether it is initial or further processing. If the User objects to the processing of personal data for the purpose of sending commercial communications (direct marketing), CyWeTa DNS undertakes to no longer process the personal data for this purpose.

## 8. Use of Cookies

**Cookies** are short text files that are created by a web server and stored on your computer via your internet browser (Internet Exporer, Firefox, Chrome, etc.). They are used to ensure that when you return to <a href="https://hackedlist.io/">https://hackedlist.io/</a> later, the browser sends the stored cookie back to the server so that it can retrieve all the information it has previously stored for you.

Cookies are used to optimise the Website and contain, for example, information about the User's previous accesses to the relevant servers or what offers have been viewed so far.

CyWeTa DNS uses the following types of "cookies":

- First party cookie (= first party cookie)
- Third party cookies (= third party cookies)

The user has the option to prevent the storage of cookies at any time. As a rule, this is done by the corresponding settings in the browser or by other procedures, see below.

## 9. Using Google Marketing Platform

The website <a href="https://hackedlist.io/">https://hackedlist.io/</a> uses the Google Marketing Platform, a web service of Google Inc. ("Google"). Google Marketing Platform uses so-called "cookies" (including third-party cookies), text files that are stored on your computer and that enable an analysis of your use of the Website. The information generated by the cookie about your use of the Website is generally transferred to and stored on a Google server in the USA. Within the member states of the European Union or other contracting states of the Agreement on the European Economic Area, Google will truncate your IP address if IP anonymisation is activated on this Website. Only in exceptional cases is the entire IP address transferred to a Google server in the USA and shortened there. On the instructions of the operator of this Website, Google will use this information to evaluate the use of the Website, to compile reports on Website activity and to provide other services relating to the use of the Website and the Internet in general. The IP address provided by your browser in the context of Google Analytics will not be associated with other data held by Google.
